



- 4. The original document in support of the date of birth and copy of Aadhar Card must be produced by the parents at the time of admission in the school.
- 5. Students coming from other school must produce photo copy of Marksheet of last appeared examination and a Transfer Certificate from the school last attended, at the time of admission.
- 6. For students coming from any school outside Varanasi district the transfer certificate must be countersigned by competetent Educational Authority of that district.

- For the classes IX & X Periodic Test-I will be conducted in the end of July and will cover 30% syllabus. Periodic Test-II will be conducted in the beginning of October and will cover 30% syllabus of Periodic Test-I + Complete syllabus covered after Periodic Test-I. Periodic Test-III will be conducted in the first week of January and will cover 10% Syllabus of Periodic Test-I + 30% Syllabus of Periodic Test-II + Complete syllabus covered after Periodic Test-II.
- 4. Co-scholastic Activities (Classes LKG to X) will be graded on a 5-point grading scale (A to E) and will have no descriptive indicators. No upscaling of grades will be done. Activities based on Work Education or Pre-Vocational education, Art education, Health and Physical Education (Sports/Martial Arts/Yoga/NCC etc.) are included in Co-scholastic activities.



- 5. The students will also be assessed for discipline which will be based on attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, national and others. Regarding it 3-point grading scale (A=outstanding, B= Very Good and C= fair) will be done term wise for the classes LKG to VIII. 5-point grading scale (A to E) will be done yearly for the classes IX &X.
- 6. Promotion of a student to next class will be determined on the basis of his/her yearly performance.
- 7. Decision of the principal, regarding promotions will be final.
- 8. A student will not be allowed to sit for any main examination if his/her fees are in arrears as per schedule of the school, mentioned in fee card as well as his/her attendance is below 75%.
